Apples

↔ The Washington market is steady. Fuji are up. All other varieties are steady. Moderate supply and demand.

Asparagus

▲ The market is up. Mexico supply is up. Light supply. Moderate demand.

Avocado

▲ Market is up. 36s, 40s, 48s, 60s, and 70s, are up. Light supply. Good demand.

Bell Peppers

▼ **Green bell peppers:** Market is down. The market is down out of Central and South FL. Light supply. Moderate demand. Mexico supply crossing through AZ is down. Moderate supply. Good demand. Quality varies.

▼ **Red bell peppers:** Market is down. Mexico supply crossing through AZ is down. Moderate supply. Good demand. Quality varies.

Berries

▼ **Strawberries:** The market is down. CA supply is moderate to good.

Broccoli

▼ The broccoli market is down. Moderate supply. Steady demand.

Carrots

↔ The market is mixed. Kern, CA supply is steady. Moderate supply. Good demand. Mexico supply is up. Moderate supply and demand. Quality varies.

Cauliflower

▼ The cauliflower market is down. Good supply. Moderate to good demand. Good quality.

Celery

▲ The celery market is up. Light supply. Fair quality.

Cucumbers

↔ Market is steady. Western supply out of Mexico through TX is steady. Mexico supply through AZ is steady. Central and South FL supply is steady. Moderate supply. Good demand. Quality varies.

Grapes

↔ Market is mixed. Red Globes are up out of Peru. Moderate supply and demand. Red Seedless, Black Seedless and White Seedless are up. Heavy supply. Light demand. Chile supply of Black Seedless is steady. Red Seedless and Red Globes are up. White Seedless are down. Good supply. Light demand. Quality varies.

Lemons

▲ Market is up. Larger size supplies are moderate. Smaller size supplies are light.

Lettuce

▼ **Iceberg:** The iceberg market is down. Moderate supply. Quality issues may include epidermal peel and mildew. Lighter pack weights possible due to cold weather.

▼ **Leaf:** The green leaf market is down. Good quality. Quality issues may include insect presence, slightly lighter in color and appearance, some irregular sizing. Good demand. Romaine market is down. Good demand. Fair to Good quality. Quality issues may include blister and peel.

Limes

▼ Market is down. 230 ct. and 250 ct. supplies are moderate. 110 ct., 150 ct. and 175 ct. supplies are light. Good quality. Quality issues may include scarring and light coloring. Supplies are increasing to meet demand.

Melons

▲ **Cantaloupe:** Market is up. Light supply. Peaking on 12 ct. and 15 ct.

▲ **Honeydew:** Market is up. Light supply.

Onions

↔ The jumbo yellow onion is mixed. WA/OR supply is down. Moderate supply. Light demand. Mexico supply through TX is up. TX supply is steady. Moderate supply and demand.

Oranges

↔ Market is flat. Light supply on smaller sizes. Good demand. Good quality.

Potatoes

↔ **Russets:** Market is steady. WA/OR and ID 70 ct. and 90 ct. Norkotahs and Burbanks are steady. Moderate supply. Good demand.

↔ **Reds:** Market is steady. FL supply is flat. Moderate supply. Good demand.

↔ **Yellow:** Market is steady. FL supply is steady. Moderate supply. Good demand.

Squash

↔ Market is mixed. Mexico supply through AZ is steady. Moderate supply. Light demand. Central and South FL is down. Moderate supply. Light demand. Mexico supply through AZ is up. Moderate supply. Good demand. Quality varies.

Tomatoes

↔ **Rounds:** The market is mixed. Mexico supply through TX is up. Mexico supply through AZ is steady. Moderate supply and demand. Central and South FL supply is down. Moderate supply and demand.

↔ **Cherry:** The market is steady. Central and South FL supply is steady. Light supply and demand.
